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## Purpose - *Take*

1. To seek a determination from the Dog Control Hearings Panel on the classification of Tanzie (the Dog) as a menacing dog.

## Staff Recommendation - *Tuutohu-aa-kaimahi*

2. That the Dog Control Hearings Panel:
  - a) receives the report; and
  - b) confirms it has considered the mandatory matters specified under the Dog Control Act 1996, and other matters relevant to the objection; and
  - c) notes that the Dog Control Hearings Panel in determining any objection can only either uphold or rescind the classification under the Dog Control Act 1996; and
  - d) either **upholds** or **rescinds** the menacing classification.

## Executive Summary - *Whakaraapopototanga matua*

3. On 29 November 2024 Council received a complaint regarding 'Tanzie' a female, unneutered Border Collie, Black and White, approximately 4 years and 2 months (the Dog) (refer to **Attachment 1**).
4. The Dog Control Act 1996 sets out the circumstances in which Council may classify a dog as menacing.
5. Staff recommend that the classification of the Dog as menacing is upheld.
6. Staff consider the decision in this report has low significance and that the recommendations comply with the Council's legal requirements.

## Background - *Koorero whaimaarama*

7. On 29 November 2024 Council received a complaint regarding 'Tanzie' a female, unneutered Border Collie, Black and White, approximately 4 years and 2 months (the Dog) (refer to **Attachment 1**). The Dog is registered to Mr Riley and Ms Fox (Owners).

8. The complaint primarily concerns the Dog charging at another dog and its owner outside the Owner's property, resulting in injuries to both. Refer to **Attachment 3** for further details.
9. On 28 January 2025 the Dog was classified by staff as menacing. Refer to **Attachment 1** for the Notice of Classification.
10. On 3 February 2025 an objection to the classification of the Dog as menacing was received from the Owners. Refer to **Attachment 2** for a copy of the objection.
11. As a result, a hearing has been convened to hear the objection. The Hearing Panel should note:
  - i. the Owners have advised that they wish to be heard in person; and
  - ii. the Complainant has advised that they wish to be heard in person.
12. The normal order of the procedure of a hearing is as follows:
  - i. opening of the meeting by the Chair;
  - ii. the Objector presents their objection and supporting evidence;
  - iii. Any witnesses in support of the objection speak to their evidence;
  - iv. the Complainant and any witnesses in opposition of the objection speak to their evidence;
  - v. Staff summarise the Committee report and makes any comments regarding information provided at the hearing;
  - vi. the Objector has the opportunity to respond to any new matters or points not already covered during the hearing;
  - vii. the hearing is closed or adjourned for a decision to be made.
13. For the avoidance of doubt:
  - i. The Chair of the hearing may change the order of the hearing at their discretion.
  - ii. There is **no** opportunity for cross examination at the hearing by any party.
  - iii. Members of the Hearings Panel may ask questions for clarification of the parties during the hearing.

### **Discussion - *Matapaki***

14. Section 33B provides that in making its determination the Committee **must** have regard to:
  - i. the evidence which formed the basis for the classification;
  - ii. any steps taken by the owner to prevent any threat to the safety of persons or animals;
  - iii. the matters relied on in support of the objection; and
  - iv. any other relevant matters.

#### Evidence which formed the basis for the classification

15. In deciding to classify the Dog, staff have relied on the following evidence:
  - i. On 29 November 2024 a complaint was received from a member of the public who was walking their Dog and was charged by the Dog. Both the owner and their dog received injuries from this attack.
  - ii. Animal control officers called the complainant to obtain a statement. They also received photos and medical records that confirmed the injuries. Refer to Attachment 3.
  - iii. A statement was taken from the complainant about the incident. Refer to Attachment 3. In this statement, the complainant describes walking his dog when he saw the Dog come out from behind a car and charge at his dog latching onto their shoulder. To intervene he had to pick up his own dog, where he received multiple bites from the Dog.

- iv. A decision to classify was made on 6 December 2024. Animal Control staff made a phone call to the Owner on 11 December 2024 advising that they would receive the paperwork in January 2025.

Matters relied on or advanced in support of the objection

- 16. The Owner objects to the classification on the following grounds:
  - i. That Council does not have the full history of the interactions between the two dogs.
  - ii. Council has received a confirmation from the Owner that the Dog has been de-sexed **(see Attachment 4)**
  - iii. On 12 February 2024 Council has also received a letter from the Owner's neighbour, outlining their interactions with the dog. **(see Attachment 4)**
- 17. Refer to **Attachment 2** for the copy of the objection.

Steps taken by the owner to prevent any threat to the safety of persons or animals

- 18. Staff are **not** aware of any further steps taken by the Owner (apart from de-sexing) to prevent any threat to the safety of persons or animals. The Owner may have further information on this matter at the hearing.

Other relevant matters

- 19. The Dog Control Act 1996 requires consideration of any other matters that the Hearings Panel considers relevant.
- 20. Council's Dog Control Policy provides direction on how Council will fulfil its legislative responsibilities pursuant to the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) and the Dog Control Bylaw. The Hearing Panel should consider whether its decision is consistent with the purposes in the Dog Control Policy, specifically:
  - i. the need to minimise danger, distress, and nuisance to the community generally;
  - ii. the need to avoid the inherent danger in allowing dogs to have uncontrolled access to public places that are frequented by children, whether or not the children are accompanied by adults;
  - iii. the importance of enabling, to the extent that is practicable, the public (including families) to use streets and public amenities without fear of attack or intimidation by dogs;
  - iv. the exercise and recreational needs of dogs and their owners.
- 21. Ownership history and recorded dog behaviour can be a relevant consideration if it provides evidence of prior good or poor dog or ownership behaviour. Council does not have any record of complaints apart from the attack on the 29 November 2024.

**Options**

- 22. Under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#), territorial authorities have two options when considering an outcome of an objection to a dog being classified as menacing:
  - i. to uphold the classification; or
  - ii. to rescind the classification.
- 23. There are no other options open to the Dog Control Hearings Panel under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#).

24. The staff recommendation is that the Hearings Panel uphold the classification for the following reasons:
- i. The dog "Tanzie" was the aggressor during the incident on 29 November 2024. The dog managed to slip its lead and attack another dog across the street. During this incident the dog "Tanzie" bit the owner of the other dog.
  - ii. One of the effects of a menacing classification is the requirement for the dog to be muzzled while in a public place to prevent it from biting.

### **Financial Considerations - *Whaiwhakaaro Puutea***

25. This is a regular operating activity funded through the Long Term Plan.

### **Legal and Policy Considerations - *Whaiwhakaaro-aa-ture***

#### Menacing Dog Classification

26. [Section 33A](#) of the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) provides that a territorial authority may classify dog as menacing that has not been classified as a dangerous dog under section 31; but a territorial authority considers may pose a threat to any person, stock, poultry, domestic animal, or protected wildlife because of—
- i. any observed or reported behaviour of the dog; or
  - ii. any characteristics typically associated with the dog's breed or type.

#### Effect of a menacing dog classification

27. If a dog is classified as a menacing dog under [section 33A](#) the owner of the dog:
- i. must not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way, except when confined completely within a vehicle or cage, without being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction; and
  - ii. must, if required by the territorial authority (refer below to Council's Dog Control Policy) within 1 month after receipt of notice of the classification, produce to the territorial authority a certificate issued by a veterinarian certifying—
    - I. that the dog is or has been neutered; or
    - II. that for reasons that are specified in the certificate, the dog will not be in a fit condition to be neutered before a date specified in the certificate; and
  - iii. must, if a non-neutering certificate is produced to the territorial authority, produce to the territorial authority, within 1 month after the date specified in that certificate, a further certificate that the dog has now been neutered.
28. A menacing classification extends to the whole of New Zealand and remains in place for the life of the dog.
29. There is no provision under the Dog Control Act 1996 to appeal this decision to the district Court.

#### Council's Dog Control Policy – Neutering of dogs classified as menacing:

30. Council's Dog Control Policy provides direction on how Council will fulfil its legislative responsibilities pursuant to the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) and the Dog Control Bylaw.
31. The [Dog Control Policy](#) requires mandatory neutering of dogs classified as menacing in accordance with the provisions of the [Dog Control Act 1996](#). Mandatory neutering also includes dogs classified as menacing by other territorial authorities where that dog is in the jurisdiction of Hamilton City Council.

### Right to make an objection

32. Section 33B provides a dog owner with the right to object to the classification. If a dog is classified under section 33A as a menacing dog, the owner:
  - i. may, within 14 days of receiving notice of the classification, object in writing to the territorial authority in regard to the classification; and
  - ii. has the right to be heard in support of the objection.
33. The territorial authority considering an objection under subsection (1) may uphold or rescind the classification, and in making its determination must have regard to—
  - i. the evidence which formed the basis for the classification; and
  - ii. any steps taken by the owner to prevent any threat to the safety of persons or animals; and
  - iii. the matters relied on in support of the objection; and
  - iv. any other relevant matters.
34. The territorial authority must, as soon as practicable, give written notice to the owner of—
  - i. its determination of the objection; and
  - ii. the reasons for its determination.

### **Climate Change Impact Statement**

35. Staff have assessed this option against the Climate Change Policy for both emissions and climate change adaptation. Staff have determined no adaptation or emissions assessment is required.

### **Wellbeing Considerations - *Whaiwhakaaro-aa-oranga tonutanga***

36. The purpose of Local Government changed on the 14 May 2019 to include promotion of the social, economic, environmental and cultural wellbeing of communities in the present and for the future ('the 4 wellbeings').
37. The subject matter of this report has been evaluated in terms of the 4 wellbeings during the process of developing this report as outlined below.
38. Staff consider that the keeping of animals can enhance the quality of life and wellbeing for individuals and families; however, the Council also has a responsibility to protect the community from unreasonable animal nuisances – families, whanau, iwi, hapuu, and communities should be safe from dangerous animals.

### **Risks - *Tuuraru***

39. Public safety risk: If a dog owner that should have been classified is not, their behaviour may mean that animals in their possession may continue to pose a potential threat to the public or other animals. This could result in attacks or incidents that cause harm.
40. Reputation and perception: Failure to properly classify a dog owner may affect the public perception of Council's approach to enforcement.

### **Significance & Engagement Policy - *Kaupapa here whakahira/anganui***

41. Staff have considered the key considerations under the Significance and Engagement Policy and have assessed that the matter(s) in this report has/have a low level of significance.
42. Given the low level of significance determined, the engagement level is low. No engagement is required.

**Classification of Dog as Menacing Dog Section 33A Dog Control Act 1996**

Section 33A of the Dog Control Act 1996 ("DCA") enables Hamilton City Council ("HCC"), to classify a dog that it considers poses a threat to any person, stock, poultry, domestic animal, or protected wildlife because of:

- a. any observed or reported behaviour of the dog; or
- b. any characteristics typically associated with the dog's breed or type.

As a result of the observed or reported behaviour HCC has classified the dog as a Menacing Dog under s33A of the Dog Control Act 1996. The Notice of Classification of Dog as Menacing Dog ("the Notice") is enclosed.

HCC requires you to have the dog de-sexed, and to provide a copy of the de-sexing certificate to HCC within one month from the date shown on the Notice.

You may be able to take advantage of discounts available through HCC for de-sexing fees with a contracted veterinarian. Microchipping is also available at the Animal Education and Control Centre. If you would like further information about these services, please contact the Animal Education and Control team on 07 838 6632.

Please ensure that you comply with the requirements of the classification within the timeframes outlined in the enclosed Notice to avoid any further enforcement action. If you do not agree with the Classification you may object in writing within 14 days of receiving the Classification, by emailing [dog.registration@hcc.govt.nz](mailto:dog.registration@hcc.govt.nz)

You must have valid ground for an objection and produce evidence that your dog is not of a breed or type listed above.



This is to notify you\* that this dog has been classified as a menacing dog under section 33A(2) of the Dog Control Act 1996.

This is because of the aggressive behavior displayed by the dog on Friday, 29th November 2024, in Hamilton.

A summary of the effect of the classification and your right to object is provided below.

\* For the purposes of the Dog Control Act 1996, you are the owner of a dog if:-

- you own the dog; or
- you have the dog in your possession (otherwise than for a period not exceeding 72 hours for the purpose of preventing the dog causing injury, damage, or distress, or for the sole purpose of restoring a lost dog to its owner); or
- you are the parent or guardian of a person under 16 who is the owner of the dog and who is a member of your household living with and dependent on you.

### S 33E(1) Effect of classification as a menacing dog

*Sections 33E, 33F, 36A, Dog Control Act 1996*

You —

- (a) must not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way (other than when confined completely within a vehicle or cage) without the dog being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction; and
- (b) must produce to HCC within 1 month after receipt of this notice, a certificate issued by a veterinary surgeon certifying —

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- (i) that the dog is or has been neutered; or
- (ii) that for reasons that are specified in the certificate, the dog will not be in a fit condition to be neutered before a date specified in the certificate; and
- (c) must, if a certificate under paragraph (b)(ii) is produced to HCC, produce to HCC, within 1 month after the date specified in that certificate, a further certificate under paragraph (b)(i).

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you fail to comply with all of the matters in paragraphs (a) to (c) above.

A dog control officer or dog ranger may seize and remove the dog from you if you fail to comply with all of the matters in paragraphs (a) to (c) above. The officer or ranger may keep the dog until you demonstrate that you are willing to comply with paragraphs (a) to (c).

You are also required, for the purposes of providing permanent identification of the dog, to arrange for the dog to be implanted with a functioning microchip transponder. This must be confirmed by making the dog available to HCC in accordance with the reasonable instructions of HCC for verification that the dog has been implanted with a functioning microchip transponder of the prescribed type and in the prescribed location.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you fail to comply with this requirement within 2 months after the dog is classified as menacing.

If the dog is in the possession of another person (for a period not exceeding 72 hours), you must advise that person of the requirement to not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way (other than when confined completely within a vehicle or cage) without the dog being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction. You will commit an offence and be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500 if you fail to comply with this requirement.

Full details of the effect of the classification of a dog as menacing are provided in the Dog Control Act 1996. This is available to view online at [www.legislation.govt.nz](http://www.legislation.govt.nz).

### **Right of Objection to Classification Under Section 33C**

*Section 33D, Dog Control Act 1996*

You may object to the classification of your dog as menacing by lodging with HCC a written objection within 14 days of receipt of this notice setting out the grounds on which you object. **This objection must be emailed to [dog.registration@hcc.govt.nz](mailto:dog.registration@hcc.govt.nz)**

Dear Susan

We have received your notification on 29 January 2025 and wish to advise you that we strongly object to your action of classifying Tanzie as being a menacing dog. This classification is totally unfair in our view and appears to be excessive, for a first offence, under the circumstances outlined below.

The basis of our dispute is that you don't appear to have all the facts around the history between Tanzie and the plaintiff's dog. We have been living at this address for more than 7 years and for a good portion of that time our neighbours and their dog have been there too. While we have only had Tanzie for 4 years their dog has constantly barked whenever we have gone out the front, opened our front door, gone into the garage and whenever we have walked passed. When we first brought Tanzie home in January 2021 as a pup we didn't initially exercise her until she was a few months older. On one occasion as [REDACTED] came home with Tanzie on her lead, the neighbour was outside their house with their dog on a lead so I walked over to chat and introduce Tanzie to their dog who unexpectedly tried to attack Tanzie but I pulled her away. Following on from then their dog has always barked aggressively, snapped and snarled whenever we walk passed or nearby.

Early 2024 as I returned from walking Tanzie we went passed their house and walked across the road to our property and while in our driveway, with Tanzie still on the lead, the neighbours dog raced across, off lead, and attacked Tanzie who was unable to defend herself until I managed to separate them with the help of the neighbour who raced over to get their dog. Since that time whenever we have meet walking around the park or on the street we have either gone a different direction or one of us moves aside to let the other pass.

Over all this period we never once considered notifying the council for either attack as we see it as dogs being dogs and we value good neighbourly relations. Just like humans don't like every person they see or meet, dogs don't like every other dog they meet. With the aggressive behaviour of the neighbours dog, how would Tanzie be able to protect herself should she be attacked again?

We request a copy of the actual complaint made by our neighbour along with any other evidence you may have collected that you used to base your decision on.

Please note that Tanzie is microchipped, as you have in your letter and she was also neutered when she was approximately 18 months old at Pet Doctors in Flagstaff, we will obtain a verification from them.

Further, we are obtaining character references to support our objection, these will be sent to you via email when available and will also be presented when we attend the hearing once you notify us of the time and place.

She has run across the road and attacked the neighbour's dog. She has run across the road and pulled Tanzie off the dog as soon as he could, apologised profusely and offered to pay his medical bills as she could see the man was bleeding. In hindsight ██████████ should have tightened Tanzie's collar. Again, a lot of prior history between the dogs that has not been reported.

I have discussed potential outcome as being advice/infringement/menacing classification or a combination but that I would review my findings before deciding upon final outcome. ██████████

I have had extensive experience with dogs, I used to clip, breed, own & show Kerrie Blue Terriers who can be feisty so I am not afraid of dog bites & know how to handle dogs. I was not going to allow this dog to pick [REDACTED] up & have grabbed the dog by the scruff of its neck & middle of its back, & have picked the dog up off the ground which has caused the dog to release [REDACTED]. During this, I have received multiple dog bites. One scrape\* on my right shin, a puncture on my left forearm & another puncture on ~~at~~ the back of my right hand. [REDACTED] has received a puncture on her left shoulder, just above the collar bone at the base of the neck. The owner has come across the road to try & control the Border Collie. cleared myself up & have gone straight to the doctor. [REDACTED] as checked [REDACTED] which is when she has found the puncture wound to her neck. [REDACTED] has cleaned & treated the wound & we will keep an eye on it. I have had quite a lot of blood which made a terrible mess (I am blood thinner) & so have cleared myself up a bit with some dettol wound spray. The doctor has cleaned & dressed wounds further, no stitches ~~required~~ required. I have received a tetanus shot & a course of antibiotics. Follow up appointment Monday to check wounds.

The offending dog is a black & white Border Collie. It has lived at [REDACTED] since it was a puppy approx 4 years. This dog has actually bitten me before, but I had a stick in my hand that I used to defend myself. I did not report this incident. This dog has also been out, with the owner present & has attacked other dogs in our street, again these incidents have not been reported. The second dog, the Huntaway, has never been a problem that I am aware of. The issue lies with the female dog owner who believes she has control of her dog when not on lead. The dog tends to be put on a lead after an incident.

I ran across, & called her & pulled her off as soon as I could. I apologised profusely, offered to pay his medical bills as I could see the man was bleeding. He swore at me, something about a 'bitch'. His wife was outside by this stage, she told him that there was no need for swearing. I have put Tanzie on her lead & tightened her collar. The lady has said "these two have not liked each other since the day they were born" & "dogs will be dogs" & that she is worried about 'him' meaning her husband. We have then carried on with our walk & have also added in an extra training session.

From the time Tanzie was a little puppy, this dog has been antagonistic towards her. We cross the road to do our walks as that is where the footpath is. Because of this, we pass the neighbour across the road's dog. The dog had never been a problem with Mungo who was the first dog here. Since we got Tanzie as a puppy, 4 years ago, the dog across the road has been ~~more~~ <sup>very</sup> antagonistic towards her. Tanzie, as a puppy, would cower as we would ~~park~~ <sup>protect</sup> the dog. The dog is never in the street, is always contained

but snaps aggressively, snappy barking as we walk along & comes to the gate. These two dogs have never really liked each other. Last year, or earlier this year, my husband has told me that while I was out, the dog from across the road has actually come up our driveway & has attacked Tanzie. 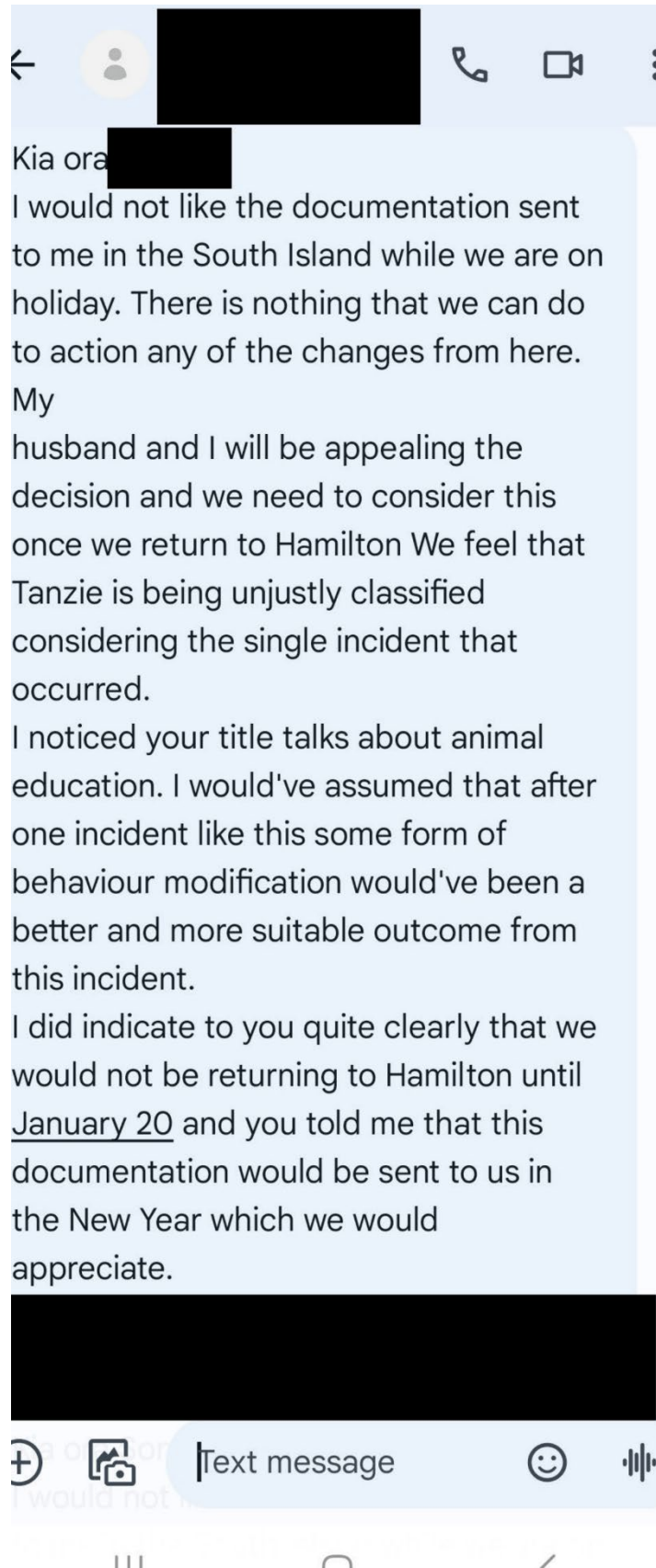

<b>Report Status</b>	<i>Open</i>
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## Purpose - *Take*

1. To seek a determination from the Dog Control Hearings Panel on the classification of Raiwhara (Owner) as a disqualified dog owner.

## Staff Recommendation - *Tuutohu-aa-kaimahi*

2. That the Dog Control Hearings Panel:
  - a) receives the report;
  - b) confirms it has considered the mandatory matters specified under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#), and other matters relevant to the objection;
  - c) notes under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) that the Dog Control Hearings Panel in determining any objection can only either:
    - i. uphold the classification;
    - ii. bring forward the date of termination of the classification; or
    - iii. immediately terminate the disqualification;
  - d) **EITHER**
    - i. classifies the dog owner as disqualified until 27 October 2027 (being the date that is 5 years from the date of the third or final infringement offence in respect of which the person is disqualified) and notes the right of the dog owner to appeal to the District Court under section 27 of the Dog Control Act 1996.
    - OR**
    - ii. amends the date of termination of the classification to [a the date that is no more than 5 years from the date of the third or final infringement offence in respect of which the person is disqualified) and notes the right of the dog owner to appeal to the District Court under section 27 of the Dog Control Act 1996.
    - OR**
    - iii. immediately terminates the classification.

## Executive Summary - *Whakaraapopototanga matua*

3. On 5 February 2025, Raiwhara (the Dog Owner) was classified by staff as disqualified from dog ownership (see **Attachment 1** for the Notice of Classification).



4. The trigger under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) for the classification was based on receipt of a number of infringements (outlined later in the report) within a 24 month period.
5. On 5 February 2025 staff received notice of an objection to the disqualified status (see **Attachment 2**). The Dog Control Act 1996 permit objections to be lodged as long as they are not within 12 months of a previous objection to the disqualification.
6. The Dog Control Act 1996 sets out the circumstances in which Council may classify a Dog Owner as disqualified.
7. The staff recommendation is that the Hearings Panel classify the dog owner as disqualified until 11 June 2029, 5 years from the date of the last infringement offence in respect of which the person is disqualified and notes the right of the dog owner to appeal to the District Court under section 27 of the Dog Control Act 1996.
8. Staff consider the decision in this report has low significance and that the recommendations comply with the Council's legal requirements

### **Background - *Koorero whaimaarama***

9. On 5 February 2025 the Dog Owner was classified by staff as disqualified from dog ownership, **Attachment 1** is the Notice of Classification, which was then objected to and is included as **Attachment 2**.
10. The trigger under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) for the classification was a number of infringements and an attack within a 24 month period. **Attachment 3** to this report outlined the disqualification process.
11. The normal order of the procedure of a hearing is as follows:
  - i. Opening of the meeting by the chairperson
  - ii. the Objector presents their objection and supporting evidence.
  - iii. Any witnesses in support of the objection speak to their evidence.
  - iv. The Complainant and any witnesses in opposition of the objection speak to their evidence.
  - v. Council staff summarise the council report and makes any comments regarding information provided at the hearing
  - vi. The Objector has the opportunity to respond to any new matters or points not already covered during the hearing.
  - vii. The hearing is closed or adjourned for a decision to be made.
12. For the avoidance of doubt:
  - i. The Chair of the hearing may change the order of the hearing at their discretion.
  - ii. There is **no** opportunity for cross examination at the hearing by any party.
  - iii. Members of the Hearings Panel may ask questions for clarification of the parties during the hearing.

### **Discussion - *Matapaki***

13. [Section 26](#) provides that in making its determination Council **must** have regard to:
  - i. the circumstances and nature of the offence or offences in respect of which the Dog Owner was classified;
  - ii. the competency of the person objecting in terms of responsible dog ownership;
  - iii. any steps taken by the owner to prevent further offences (including, but not limited to, the disposal of any dog or dogs or the fencing of the property on which the dog is kept);
  - iv. the matters advanced in support of the objection; and
  - v. any other relevant matters.

Circumstances and nature of the offence(s) in respect of which the person was originally disqualified

14. In deciding to classify the Dog Owner, staff relied on the following evidence which is included in **Attachment 4**:
- i. Infringement 14991 issued on 7 July 2023 – Section 52A of the Dog Control Act – Failure to Control or Confine a Dog
  - ii. Infringement 13791 issued on 8 July 2023– Section 20(5) Failure to Comply with HCC Bylaw
  - iii. Infringement 15449 issued on 27 May 2024- Section 33E of the Dog Control Act – Failure to comply with Menacing Dog Classification
  - iv. Infringement 15450 issued on 27 May 2024 – Section 52A of the Dog Control Act – Failure to keep Dog Under Control

Matters advanced in support of the objection

15. The Dog Owner has not provided any reasons for the objections but may be able to provide more information at the Hearings Panel.

The competency of the person objecting in terms of responsible dog ownership

16. Ownership history and recorded dog behaviour can be a relevant consideration if it provides evidence of prior good or poor dog ownership behaviour.
17. The complaints and infringements issued are outlined in this report and **Attachment 4**, indicating a period of several months where the Dog Owner has been aware of the behaviour of their dog, and not remedied this behaviour.

Steps taken by the Dog Owner to prevent any further offences

18. The Dog "Boy" was classified as menacing following one incident (refer to **Attachment 1 and 4**) which was not objected to by the Owner.
19. In terms of steps taken by the Dog Owner to prevent any further offences, the Dog "Boy" has now been rehomed and is with another owner. The Dog Owner may have further information on this matter at the hearing.

Other relevant matters

20. The [Dog Control Act 1996](#) requires consideration of any other matters that the Hearings Panel considers relevant.

21. Council's Dog Control Policy provides direction on how Council will fulfil its legislative responsibilities pursuant to the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) and the Dog Control Bylaw. The Hearing Panel should consider whether its decision is consistent with the purposes in the Dog Control Policy, specifically:
- i. the need to minimise danger, distress, and nuisance to the community generally;
  - ii. the need to avoid the inherent danger in allowing dogs to have uncontrolled access to public places that are frequented by children, whether or not the children are accompanied by adults;
  - iii. the importance of enabling, to the extent that is practicable, the public (including families) to use streets and public amenities without fear of attack or intimidation by dogs;
  - iv. the exercise and recreational needs of dogs and their owners.

### Options

22. Under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#), the Hearing Panel has limited options when considering an outcome of an objection to a decision to classify a Dog Owner as disqualified. The Hearing Panel may:
- i. uphold the classification;
  - ii. bring forward the date of termination of the classification; or
  - iii. immediately terminate the disqualification.
23. There are no other options open to the Hearings Panel under the Dog Control Act 1996.
24. The staff recommendation is that the Hearings Panel upholds the classification of the Dog Owner as disqualified until 11 June 2029 being five years from the date the Owner was convicted of an offence (not being an infringement offence) against this Act and notes the right of the dog owner to appeal to the District Court under [section 27](#) of the [Dog Control Act 1996](#).
25. Staff make this recommendation for the following reasons:
- i. The Dog Owner has shown an extensive history of not being able to contain and confine her animal
  - ii. A Dog in her possession was involved in an attack which cause Moderate injuries
  - iii. The Dog Owner was unable to comply with the effects of the Menacing Classification her Dog received.
26. It is the professional opinion of staff that the Owner is either unwilling or unable to be a responsible Dog Owner and recommend the classification being upheld.

### Financial Considerations - *Whaiwhakaaro Puutea*

27. This is a regular operating activity funded through the Long-Term Plan.

### Legal and Policy Considerations - *Whaiwhakaaro-aa-ture*

#### Disqualified Classification

28. [Section 25](#) of the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) provides that a territorial authority must classify a Dog Owner as disqualified if:
- i. the person commits 3 or more infringement offences (not relating to a single incident or occasion) within a continuous period of 24 months; or
  - ii. the person is convicted of an offence (not being an infringement offence) against the Dog Control Act 1996; or
  - iii. the person is convicted of an offence against Part 1 or Part 2 of the Animal Welfare Act 1999, section 26ZZP of the Conservation Act 1987, or section 56I of the National Parks Act 1980.



29. This requirement does not apply if the territorial authority is satisfied that the circumstances of the offence or offences are such that:
- disqualification is not warranted; or
  - the territorial authority staff will instead classify the person as a probationary owner under section 21.

#### Effect of classification as a disqualified owner

30. A disqualification under the [Dog Control Act 1996](#) continues in force for a period specified by the territorial authority not exceeding five years from the date of the third infringement offence(s) in respect of which the person is disqualified.
31. The disqualified owner must:
- within 14 days dispose of every dog owned by the person; and
  - not be in possession of a dog at any time (there are some limited exceptions to this).
32. The disqualification extends over all of New Zealand.

#### Right to make an objection

33. [Section 26](#) provides a dog owner with the right to object to Council, to the classification as disqualified.
34. An objection under [Section 26](#) may be lodged at any time but no objection can be lodged within 12 months of the hearing of any previous objection to the disqualification.
35. The territorial authority must, as soon as practicable, give written notice to the owner of:
- its determination of the objection;
  - the reasons for its determination; and
  - the right of appeal to the District Court under section 27.

#### Appeal to the District Court

36. Any person who has lodged an objection under [section 26](#) and is dissatisfied with the decision of the territorial authority may, within 14 days of the date on which notice of that decision is given to that person, appeal to the District Court against that decision.
37. The District Court, in hearing the appeal, shall consider the matters specified in [section 26\(3\)](#) and any submission by the territorial authority in support of its decision, and may uphold the determination, bring forward the date of termination, or immediately terminate the disqualification.

### **Wellbeing Considerations - *Whaiwhakaaro-aa-oranga tonutanga***

38. The purpose of Local Government changed on the 14 May 2019 to include promotion of the social, economic, environmental and cultural wellbeing of communities in the present and for the future ('the 4 wellbeings').
39. The subject matter of this report has been evaluated in terms of the 4 wellbeings during the process of developing this report as outlined below.
40. Staff consider that the keeping of animals can enhance the quality of life and wellbeing for individuals and families; however, the Council also has a responsibility to protect the community from unreasonable animal nuisances – families, whanau, iwi, hapuu, and communities should be safe from dangerous animals.

**Risks - *Tuuraru***

41. Public safety risk: If a dog owner that should have been classified is not, their behaviour may mean that animals in their possession may continue to pose a potential threat to the public or other animals. This could result in attacks or incidents that cause harm.
42. Reputation and perception: Failure to properly classify a dog owner may affect the public perception of Council's approach to enforcement.

**Significance & Engagement Policy - *Kaupapa here whakahira/anganui***

43. Staff have considered the key considerations under the Significance and Engagement Policy and have assessed that the recommendation(s) in this report has/have a low level of significance.
44. Given the low level of significance determined, the engagement level is low. No engagement is required.

Section 33A of the Dog Control Act 1996 ("DCA") enables Hamilton City Council ("HCC"), to classify a dog that it considers poses a threat to any person, stock, poultry, domestic animal, or protected wildlife because of:

- a. any observed or reported behaviour of the dog; or
- b. any characteristics typically associated with the dog's breed or type.

As a result of the observed or reported behaviour HCC has classified the dog as a Menacing Dog under s33A of the Dog Control Act 1996. The Notice of Classification of Dog as Menacing Dog ("the Notice") is enclosed.

HCC requires you to have the dog de sexed, and to provide a copy of the de-sexing certificate to HCC within one month from the date shown on the Notice.

You may be able to take advantage of discounts available through HCC for de-sexing fees with a contracted veterinarian. Microchipping is also available at the Animal Education and Control Centre. If you would like further information about these services, please contact the Animal Education and Control team on 838 6632.

Please ensure that you comply with the requirements of the classification within the timeframes outlined in the enclosed Notice to avoid any further enforcement action. If you do not agree with the Classification you may object in writing within 14 days of receiving the Classification. You must have valid ground for an objection and produce evidence that your dog is not of a breed or type listed above.



- (c) must, if a certificate under paragraph (b)(ii) is produced to HCC, produce to HCC, within 1 month after the date specified in that certificate, a further certificate under paragraph (b)(i).

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you fail to comply with all of the matters in paragraphs (a) to (c) above.

A dog control officer or dog ranger may seize and remove the dog from you if you fail to comply with all of the matters in paragraphs (a) to (c) above. The officer or ranger may keep the dog until you demonstrate that you are willing to comply with paragraphs (a) to (c).

You are also required, for the purposes of providing permanent identification of the dog, to arrange for the dog to be implanted with a functioning microchip transponder. This must be confirmed by making the dog available to HCC in accordance with the reasonable instructions of HCC for verification that the dog has been implanted with a functioning microchip transponder of the prescribed type and in the prescribed location.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you fail to comply with this requirement within 2 months after the dog is classified as menacing.

If the dog is in the possession of another person (for a period not exceeding 72 hours), you must advise that person of the requirement to not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way (other than when confined completely within a vehicle or cage) without the dog being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction. You will commit an offence and be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500 if you fail to comply with this requirement.

## Disqualification from dog ownership

### Disqualification triggers

- Conviction under any of the following Acts
  - Dog Control Act 1996
  - Animal Welfare Act 1999
  - Conservation Act 1987
  - National Parks Act 1980 or
- The person commits 3 or more separate infringement offences in a 24 month period  
(note: infringement related disqualification may only occur after the infringements have been paid or if unpaid laid in court)

### Infringement Process

#### Dog owner issued an infringement as the result of an offence under the Dog Control Act 1996

- Infringement is to be paid within 28 days of the date of issue, the date of issue used is approximately 1 week after postage date e.g. infringement being posted on 15<sup>th</sup> of the month will have an issue date of 22<sup>nd</sup> of the month, this is to take into account postal delivery times.
  - An infringement is only issued at the end of an investigation and how soon after the event it is issued will depend on the event complexity.
  - Animal Education and Control have 6 months from the date of the offence to issue an infringement and lay it in Court.

#### Reminder letter sent

(INF issued – reminder 6-8 weeks)

- Approximately **6-8 weeks** after the infringement is issued a reminder letter is posted to anyone whose infringement remains unpaid.
  - A further 28 days is allowed for payment of the infringement, plus some additional time to consider postal delivery times.

#### Laid in Court

(Reminder – Laid in Court 6-8 weeks)

- A further **6-8 weeks** after the reminder letter has been sent any unpaid infringements are laid in Court.
  - From the conclusion of an investigation, an infringement being issued and then being laid in court can take **4-5 months**.
  - This process is followed for any subsequent infringements a dog owner may incur.

(Completion of infringement process 4-5 months)

#### Disqualification documentation created and delivered (if dog owner committed has 3 or more infringement offences)

- Once an infringement process has been completed Animal Education and Control admin staff create the documentation and arrange its service by one of the Animal Education and Control Officers.

Upon seeing us, Boy has disappeared into some bushes and we have lost sight of him. Other AECOs have been in the area and I have requested backup. D47 has called D/O and person who was last looking after the dog (details from previous CRM). Boy is supposed to be at [REDACTED], being looked after by D/Os father. I have relayed this info to other officers and have then received a call from D40 advising they have just sighted the dog on Bartholomew Drive. D47 and I have headed to this area to find D41, D37 and D40 placing the dog into a vehicle after having caught him.

Impound letter sent and D/O [REDACTED] phoned. I have discussed how many officers were involved in catching Boy due to his nature and that they need to sort out containment no matter where he is staying.
