Report Status	<i>Open</i>
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Purpose

1. To seek a determination from the Dog Control Hearings Panel on the disqualification from dog ownership of Kaz Thompson.

Staff Recommendation

2. That the Dog Control Hearings Panel:
 - a) receives the report; and
 - b) determines that the disqualification from dog ownership of Kaz Thompson is upheld.

Executive Summary

3. Section 25 of the Dog Control Act 1996 notes that a territorial authority must disqualify a person from being a dog owner if they have received three infringements in a 24-month period or committed an offence under the following acts:
 - The Dog Control Act 1996
 - Part 1 or Part 2 of the Animal Welfare Act 1999
 - Section 26ZZP of the Conservation Act 1987 or
 - Section 56I of the National Parks Act 1980.
4. Kaz Thompson has an extensive history with Animal Education and Control (AEC) and has received three infringements under the Dog Control Act 1996 within a 24-month period.
5. Staff recommend that the Hearings and Engagement Committee uphold the disqualification for the recommended period, as detailed in the options section below.
6. Staff have considered the key considerations under the Significance and Engagement Policy and have assessed that the matter in this report has a low level of significance.

Background

7. Kaz Thompson was disqualified from dog ownership on 8 October 2019 (**Attachment 1**) and his written objection was received on 26 October 2019 (**Attachment 2**). After a dog owner has received three infringements within a 24-month period the Council must disqualify them from dog ownership (see Legal and Policy section, paragraphs 26-29).
8. "Tama" is a two-year-old male Neapolitan Mastiff cross, grey and brindle in colour. He is small for a Neapolitan Mastiff but is still a relatively big dog, being larger than a Labrador.
9. There is an extensive history of contact between AEC and "Tama" and his owners, including:
 - 22 roaming incidents
 - 2 reports of "Tama" being stolen (found and returned by AEC)
 - 1 rushing
 - 1 attack (dog versus dog)
 - 1 unregistered follow-up
 - 2 service of documentation (disqualification and menacing).
10. The above incidents have resulted in:
 - 21 impoundings
 - 3 infringements (see **Attachment 3**)
 - Infringement 12036, failure to keep dog controlled/confined
 - Infringement 12037, failure to keep dog controlled/confined
 - Infringement 12039, failure to keep dog controlled/confined
 - 4 incidents of "Tama" being returned home.
11. Six of the incidents, including the rushing, attack, unregistered follow-up and three roamings, have all occurred subsequent to "Tama's" owner being issued with the notification of disqualification from dog ownership. (For full history, see **Attachment 4**).
12. "Tama's" behaviour is becoming a concern. Over time he is showing aggression when out roaming as evident by the reported rushing and dog attack.
13. Subsequent to the initial publication of this report for the Dog Hearing Committee meeting, scheduled for 25 March 2020, AEC have received another complaint about "Tama".
14. On 26 March 2020 it was reported that "Tama" jumped the fence where he lives, run towards the complainants wife and has made contact with her. Neither the complainant or his wife is sure if "Tama" bit her or his claws scratch her but as a result of the incident the complainants wife received bruising and broken skin to her outer left upper thigh (CRM194357).
15. As an outcome of the investigation "Tama's" owners were infringed and "Tama" is to be classified as dangerous.

Discussion

16. In considering their decision, committee members should consider the following:
 - The number of incidents that have occurred.
 - The nature and seriousness of those incidents.
 - Any escalation in behaviour demonstrated by the dog.
 - What steps the dog owner has taken to prevent further occurrences and the timeliness of those actions.
 - The potential impact to public safety.

17. [Roaming dogs across Hamilton city](#) are an issue which has been highlighted recently. Dogs that roam frequently expand their “territory” and can show signs of aggression towards people or animals that enter it, posing a risk to public safety.
18. “Tama” has one of the worst roaming histories (24 incidents) that staff at AEC have seen and his behaviour has become worse. Three roaming/failure to contain incidents resulted in more serious behaviours; two attacks (1 dog v dog and 1 dog v person) and a rushing.
19. To date it would appear little has been done to prevent “Tama” from roaming; since his owner was disqualified there has been a further five incidents of roaming behaviour.
20. Kaz Thompson is objecting to disqualification from dog ownership on the following grounds:
 - “Tama” is a loved family member.
 - He protects the family when Kaz has work away from home.
 - He is looking for a more suitably fenced property to live at.
 - “Tama” is due to be de-sexed when a skin condition has cleared (Vet report – **Attachment 5**).

Options

21. Under the Dog Control Act 1996 Territorial Authorities have four potential outcomes/options in determining an objection to disqualification, they are:
 - I. uphold the disqualification for the recommended period.
 - II. uphold the disqualification but bring the termination date forward.
 - III. terminate the disqualification immediately.
 - IV. change the disqualification to that of probationary owner.
22. Staff recommend option one because of the extensive history that “Tama” has with AEC and the escalation in his behaviour.
23. Kaz Thompson has not demonstrated responsible dog ownership in that little action was taken to prevent “Tama” from roaming even subsequent to the issuing of the three infringements and disqualification from dog ownership.
24. Should the disqualification be overturned AEC believe “Tama” would pose an ongoing risk to public safety demonstrated by his escalating behaviour (dog attack and rushing) and the owner’s failure to keep him contained.

Financial Considerations

25. This is a regular operating activity funded through the 2018-2028 Long Term Plan.

Legal and Policy Considerations

26. [Section 25](#) of the Dog Control Act 1996 notes that a territorial authority must disqualify a person from being a dog owner if they have received three infringements in a 24 month period or committed an offence under the following acts:
 - The Dog Control Act 1996
 - Part 1 or Part 2 of the Animal Welfare Act 1999
 - Section 26ZZP of the Conservation Act 1987 or
 - Section 56I of the National Parks Act 1980
27. [Section 26](#) of the Dog Control Act 1996 sets a person’s right to object to disqualification from dog ownership and the territorial authorities’ responsibilities in considering that objection.

28. If a dog owner is dissatisfied with the outcome from the territorial authority's hearing process under [section 27](#) of the Dog Control Act they may appeal to the District Court.
29. Staff confirm that the disqualification and options provided for the Dog Control Hearings Panel complies with the Council's legal obligations under the Dog Control Act 1996.

Wellbeing Considerations

30. The purpose of Local Government changed on the 14 May 2019 to include promotion of the social, economic, environmental and cultural wellbeing of communities in the present and for the future ('the 4 wellbeings').
31. The subject matter of this report has been evaluated in terms of the 4 wellbeings during the process of developing this report.
32. The recommendations set out in this report are consistent with that purpose.

Risks

33. Should the disqualification be overturned AEC believe "Tama" would pose an ongoing risk to public safety demonstrated by his escalating behaviour (dog attack and rushing) and the owner's failure to keep him contained.

Significance & Engagement Policy

34. Staff have considered the key considerations under the Significance and Engagement Policy and have assessed that the matter(s) in this report has/have a low level of significance.

EFFECT OF DISQUALIFICATION
Section 28, Dog Control Act 1996

You are required to dispose of every dog owned by you within 14 days of the date of this notice.

However, you may not dispose of a dog-

- to a person who resides at the same address as you; or
- in a way that constitutes an offence against the Dog Control Act 1996 or any other Act.

You must not become the owner, even on a temporary basis, of any dog while you are disqualified. You may have possession of a dog only for the purpose of-

- preventing it from causing injury, damage, or distress; or
- returning, within 72 hours, a lost dog to a territorial authority for the purpose of restoring the dog to its owner.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you-

- fail to dispose of every dog owned by you within 14 days of this notice; or
- at any time while disqualified, become the owner of any dog; or
- dispose of a dog owned by you-
- to a person who resides at the same address as you; or
- in a manner that constitutes an offence against the Dog Control Act 1996 or any other Act.

If you are convicted of the first or second of these offences, your period of disqualification may be further extended.

You will also commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you dispose or give custody or possession of a dog to a person knowing that person to be disqualified from ownership under section 25 of the Dog Control Act 1996.

Full details of the effect of disqualification are provided in the Dog Control Act 1996.

RIGHT OF OBJECTION TO DISQUALIFICATION
Section 26, Dog Control Act

You may object to the disqualification by lodging a written objection with the Hamilton City Council setting out the grounds on which you object. You are entitled to be heard in support of your objection and will be notified of the time and place when your objection will be heard. No objection can be lodged within 12 months of the hearing of any previous objection to the disqualification. If an objection is lodged within 14 days after the date of this notice, the requirement to dispose of every dog owned by you will be suspended until the Hamilton City Council has determined the objection.

There is a further right of appeal to the District Court if you are dissatisfied with the decision of the Hamilton City Council on your objection.

To whom it may concern:

My name's Lily, and I'm the veterinarian that is currently looking after Tama for his care. I have been asked by the owner to write a letter to the City Council to explain why Tama cannot have his desexing surgery currently.

I have examined Tama today, and he has a very severe generalised skin infection, covering most of his chest/belly/groin area. He has been prescribed a course of antibiotics/medications to help clear this up, and it may take at least 3-6 weeks before full resolution. Tama's owners had booked him in for his castration surgery with us next week, but we have had to post-pone this surgery, as the risks of operating on infected skin and causing secondary infection is too high.

Skin infections can take a couple of weeks to fully resolve, so it will take some time and a few recheck appointments with us, before we will know when he can be rescheduled for the surgery again.

He helps keep my wife safe and lets her know when unwanted visitors or strangers come on to the property by barking.

We have had him now for 2years and with his record we have paid alot of money to keep him out of the pound as we love him like our own and we are willing to comply in order to keep Tama.

Report Status	<i>Open</i>
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Purpose

1. To seek a determination from the Dog Control Hearings Panel on the classification of “Baby” as a dangerous dog.

Staff Recommendation

2. That the Dog Control Hearings Panel:
 - a) receives the report; and
 - b) determines that the classification of “Baby” as a dangerous dog is upheld.

Executive Summary

3. “Baby” is an eight-year-old Pit Bull Terrier cross with an extensive history of contact with Animal Education and Control (AEC) for roaming, rushings and attacks. On 16 January 2020, “Baby” attacked and bit a member of the public, resulting in the dog being classified as dangerous on the sworn evidence of an Animal Education and Control Officer (AECO).
4. Section 31 of the Dog Control Act 1996 sets out the circumstances in which a Territorial Authority must classify a dog as dangerous and outlines a dog owner’s right to object to that classification (as detailed in paragraphs 25-27 of this report).
5. Staff recommend that the classification of “Baby” as a dangerous dog is upheld (option A) as detailed in paragraphs 22-23 below.
6. Staff consider the decision in this report has low significance and that the recommendations comply with the Council’s legal requirements.

Background

7. In 2012, “Baby”, an eight-year-old, brown and white Pit Bull Terrier cross, was registered to Azmat Ahmadi; in 2015 ownership transferred to Yalda Ahmadi, Azmat’s sibling. Ownership was transferred due to a change in personal circumstances for Azmat Ahmadi.
8. “Baby” has a lengthy history of contact with AEC including:

- 15 roaming complaints received
- 3 rushings
- 2 attacks (1 dog vs dog, 1 dog vs person)
- 2 unregistered dog follow-ups
- 2 barking complaints received.

(For the full history, see Attachment 1).

9. "Baby" was classified as menacing by breed in 2013. Consequently, "Baby" was required to be de-sexed and to wear a muzzle when out in public.
10. On 15 January 2020 at approximately 4pm, Brett Whiteley, a member of the public, was door knocking in Bankwood Rd to talk to people about their local church. As he walked down the drive of the dog owner's property, "Baby" came out from behind a car "snarling and showing teeth". The dog was not contained or tied up; Brett did not see any sign noting there was a dog was on the property.
11. Brett backed down the drive, trying to keep the dog from biting him. When he was close to the road he tripped and fell backwards; "Baby" then bit his left hand and backed off.
12. The people from the house then secured the dog and Brett sought medical attention for his hand, which required stitches.
13. On 16 January 2020, AEC received a complaint from Brett that he had been bitten by a dog the previous day; CRM 190933 was created (see Attachment 2).
14. As a result of this attack, "Baby" was classified as dangerous on the sworn evidence of AECO D37 (see Attachment 3 – Dangerous classification).

Discussion

15. In considering their decision, committee members should consider the following:
 - The incident that formed the basis for the classification.
 - The number and type of incidents that have occurred.
 - Any escalation in behaviour demonstrated by the dog.
 - The potential impact to public safety.
16. [Roaming dogs across Hamilton city](#) is an issue that has been highlighted recently. Dogs that roam frequently expand their territory and can show signs of aggression towards people or animals that enter it, posing a risk to public safety.
17. "Baby" has a lengthy history of contact with AEC for roaming, barking, rushing and attacks, including the attack that resulted in "Baby" being classified as dangerous. Previous rushings/attack outcomes have resulted in advice given or being unsubstantiated as victims/witnesses have not wanted to give formal statements.
18. To date, it seems that the dog owner has not taken sufficient action to contain "Baby" and prevent her from roaming; the dog's escalating behaviour poses an on-going risk to public safety.
19. The dog owner appears to have little understanding of her responsibilities as an owner of a menacing dog. She has asked if the dog would require muzzling once classified as dangerous, which suggests that she did not know that her dog currently should be muzzled when out in public. This lack of understanding may have contributed to the inaction to prevent "Baby" from roaming or ensuring she was adequately contained. On the day of the attack on Brett and when the AECO visited, "Baby" was not contained.

20. Yalda Ahmadi is objecting to the classification of “Baby” as dangerous on the following grounds:
- The dog has not done this before.
 - The family has been robbed so now “Baby” is more alert.
 - She only barks when there are visitors.
 - Baby roamed previously because the gate was not well secured and they believe that as dogs get bored they will go for a stroll.
 - She believes that “Baby” would never hurt anyone.
 - There is a sign alerting people to a dog being on the property.
 - The dangerous classification would stop “Baby” being social and being out freely.
 - “Baby” is friendly and does not hurt anyone intentionally (see Attachment 4 – Objection received).

Options

21. Under the Dog Control Act 1996, territorial authorities have two options when considering an outcome of an objection to a dog being classified as dangerous:
- A. To uphold the classification, or
 - B. To overturn the classification.
22. Staff recommend option A because “Baby” has a long history of roaming and not being adequately contained, which culminated in the attack for which she was classified as dangerous. The dog owner’s failure to contain “Baby” even after repeated interactions with AEC indicates a disregard for her obligations as a dog owner to contain and control her dog. The dangerous classification will place stricter obligations on the dog owner regarding “Baby’s” containment, which should reduce her risk to public safety.

Financial Considerations

23. This is a regular operating activity funded through the Long-Term Plan.

Legal and Policy Considerations

24. [Section 31](#) of the Dog Control Act 1996 sets out the circumstances in which a territorial authority must classify a dog as dangerous including:
- The owner has been convicted of owning a dog that has attacked
 - On the basis of sworn evidence attesting to aggressive behaviour by the dog
 - The owner of the dog admits in writing the dog is dangerous.
25. [Section 31](#) also outlines a dog owner’s right to object to the classification to the territorial authority.
26. [Section 32](#) sets out the effects and the owner’s obligation of owning a dog classified as dangerous.
27. Staff confirm that the classification of dangerous and options provided for the Dog Control Hearings Panel complies with the Council’s legal requirements under the Dog Control Act 1996.

Wellbeing Considerations

28. The purpose of Local Government changed on the 14 May 2019 to include promotion of the social, economic, environmental and cultural wellbeing of communities in the present and for the future (‘the 4 wellbeings’).

29. The subject matter of this report has been evaluated in terms of the 4 wellbeings during the process of developing this report as outlined below.

Social wellbeing

30. The Council considers that the keeping of animals can enhance the quality of life and well-being for individuals and families; however, the Council also has a responsibility to protect the community from unreasonable animal nuisances – families, whanau, iwi, haapu, and communities should be safe from dangerous animals.

Risks

31. Should the dangerous classification be overturned, removing the additional owner obligations around containment, AEC staff believe “Baby” will continue to roam and pose an ongoing risk to public safety as demonstrated by her escalating behaviour (the attack for which she was classified as dangerous).

Significance & Engagement Policy

Significance

32. Staff have considered the key considerations under the Significance and Engagement Policy and have assessed that the recommendation(s) in this report has/have a low level of significance.

Engagement

33. Given the low level of significance determined, the engagement level is low. No engagement is required.

EFFECT OF CLASSIFICATION AS A DANGEROUS DOG

Section 32 and 36A Dog Control Act 1996

You are required, -

- (a) Within one month after receipt of this notice, to ensure that the dog is kept within a securely fenced portion of your property that it is not necessary to enter to obtain access to at least one door of any dwelling on the property; and
- (b) Not to allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way, (other than when confined completely within a vehicle or cage) without-
 - (i) the dog being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breath and drink without obstruction; and
 - (ii) the dog being controlled on a leash (except in a designated dog exercise area); and
- (c) To produce to the Hamilton City Council, within one month after receipt of this notice, a certificate issued by a registered veterinary surgeon and certifying:
 - (i) that the dog is or has been neutered; or
 - (ii) that for reasons that are specified in the certificate, the dog will not be in a fit condition to be neutered before a date specified in the certificate; and
- (d) Where a certificate under paragraph (c)(ii) is produced to the Hamilton City Council, to produce to the Hamilton City Council, within one month after the date specified in that certificate, a further certificate under paragraph (c)(i); and
- (e) In respect of every registration year commencing after receipt of this notice, to pay dog control fees for the dog at 150% of the level that would apply if the dog were not classified as a dangerous dog; and
- (f) Not to dispose of the dog to any other person without the written consent of the territorial authority in whose district the dog is to be kept.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you fail to comply with any of the matters in paragraphs (a) to (f) above. In addition, on conviction the Court must order the destruction of the dog unless satisfied that the circumstances of the offence were exceptional and do not justify the destruction of the dog.

A dog control officer or dog ranger may seize and remove the dog from you if you fail to comply with all of the matters in paragraphs (a) to (f) above. The ranger or officer may keep the dog until you demonstrate that you are willing to comply with paragraphs (a) to (f).

COPY

You will also commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you sell or otherwise transfer the dog, or offer to do so, to any other person without disclosing that the dog is classified as a dangerous dog.

As from 1 July 2006, you are also required, for the purpose of providing permanent identification of the dog, to arrange for the dog to be implanted with a functioning microchip transponder. This must be confirmed by making the dog available to the Hamilton City Council in accordance with the reasonable instructions of the Hamilton City Council for verification that the dog has been implanted with a functioning microchip transponder of the prescribed type and in the prescribed location.

You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$3,000 if you fail to comply with this requirement-

- within 2 months from 1 July 2006 if your dog is classified as menacing on or after 1 December 2003 but before 1 July 2006;
or
- within 2 months after the dog is classified as menacing if your dog is classified as menacing after 1 July 2006.

If the dog is in the possession of another person for a period not exceeding 72 hours, you must advise that person of the requirement to not allow the dog to be at large or in any public place or in any private way (other than when confined completely within a vehicle or cage) without the dog being muzzled in such a manner as to prevent the dog from biting but to allow it to breathe and drink without obstruction. You will commit an offence and be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500 if you fail to comply with this requirement.

Full details of the effect of classification as a dangerous dog are provided in the Dog Control Act 1996.
