- The Committee may make recommendations to the Council.
- The Committee may make recommendations to Committees.

Special Notes:

- The Committee may request expert advice through the Chief Executive when necessary.
- The Committee may appoint additional members for hearings where the relevant terms of reference specify the requirement for expert or external representation.

5. Parking Restrictions and Traffic Bylaw Changes

The Network Operations and Use Leader introduced the item and provided a background to the consultation process in relation to the proposed Five Cross Roads area safety improvements.

Mr Deon Gregory, resident of Peachgrove Road, spoke to proposed raised pedestrian crossing. He noted the difficulty he had exiting his driveway, and his concerns regarding the proposed crossing.

Staff responded to questions from Committee Members concerning increase in foot traffic numbers, design of the raised pedestrian crossings, vehicular traffic volumes, the distance of the proposed crossing to driveways, the possibility of lowering the speed limit in between crossings on Peachgrove Road, the cost of relocating bus stops, and objections to proposed parking restrictions on Vialou Street.

Staff Action: Staff undertook to report back to the next Hearings and Engagement Committee for options concerning moving the bus stop and/or the raised pedestrian crossing proposed near #276 Peachgrove Road.

Purpose - Take

1. To seek approval from the Hearings and Engagement Committee of the proposed changes to traffic controls throughout the city.

2. To seek approval from the Hearings and Engagement Committee to install a raised safety platform in Peachgrove Road just north of Claude Street.

- c) approves the gazetting of the bus stops as listed in attached 1 to this report; and
- d) approves the installation of a raised safety platform across Peachgrove Road outside #267 Peachgrove Road.

Executive Summary - Whakaraapopototanga matua

- 4. The Hamilton City Traffic Bylaw 2015 sets out the requirements for transport related activities within the road reserve. A Council resolution is required to make changes to any of these restrictions.
- 5. The changes proposed for approval in this report to be considered are parking restriction changes including No Stopping, bus stops and time limits.
- 6. Changes are recommended to improve safety and accessibility which may have been identified by residents, businesses or staff.
- 7. Consultation has been completed for all proposed changes and generally there is support for these. We have received some feedback on two locations (Newcastle Road and Cornice Place) and these are discussed further in the report.
- 8. A proposed minor safety improvement in Peachgrove Road to support the recent speed limit change to 30km/h and improved pedestrian safety and accessibility has not been supported by the adjacent property owners. Approval is being sought for this work to proceed despite these objections.
- 9. Staff consider that the decisions in this report have low significance and that the recommendations comply with the Council's legal requirements.

Background - Kooreo whaimaarama

- 10. The Hamilton City Traffic Bylaw 2015 (the Traffic Bylaw) sets out the requirements for a variety of restrictions within the road reserve including:
 - parking
 - general control of vehicular or other traffic e.g. banning of turns, installation of No Stopping restrictions
 - creation of cycle lanes
 - establishment of specific parking zones such as bus stops, taxi stands, loading zones.
- 11. A resolution is required to make changes to any of these restrictions.
- 12. Regular changes to traffic restrictions (including parking controls) are required throughout the city often in response to requests from the general public or businesses in regard to safety or accessibility concerns.

13. Opportunities for improvement are also identified by staff when considering changes in parking use patterns, or changes made to the built environment e.g. developments or discretionary transport projects.

Parking Restriction Changes

- 14. Several changes are proposed to parking restrictions throughout the city and the details of each of these are illustrated for each site in Attachment 1 and Attachment 2 (bus stops only), with a list of all proposed changes included in Attachment 3.
- 15. As part of the review of parking restrictions throughout the city, it has been determined that many bus stops have been installed but not been formally gazetted in the past. These bus stops are all 12m bus stops which have a signal 'bus stop' sign in place and do not have the yellow 'box' markings. A map of the bus stop locations is included as Attachment 2 to this report.
- 16. Consultation with adjacent property owners, occupiers and any other affected parties has been undertaken for each of the proposed changes. Feedback from residents has been received from two locations (Newcastle Road and Cornice Place) and information on this is provided below.

Newcastle Road

17. Requests for No Stopping restrictions to be installed on the service lane on the eastern side of Newcastle Road between Dinsdale Road and Ellicott Road (shown in Figure 1 below) were received following the commencement of a new development that is accessed off the lane.



Figure 1 – Newcastle Road Service Lane between Dinsdale Road and Ellicott Road

- 18. The No Stopping restrictions have been proposed on the property side of the lane thereby allowing the maximum amount of parking to remain.
- 19. In completing the consultation, we have received positive feedback on the proposed No Stopping restrictions but had several respondents also ask for No Stopping to be installed on both sides. The lane is narrow and concerns have been expressed by several respondents

about their ability to get in and out of their properties and for trucks (rubbish and fire) to move along the lane when vehicles are parked there as shown in Figure 2 below



Figure 2 – Newcastle Road service lane is narrow with little room for trucks to move along if cars are parked on road.

20. Staff propose to install the No Stopping as consulted upon on just the one side, but will go back out and consult with all of the service lane residents to seek feedback on installing additional No Stopping restrictions on the other side as well. If there is support for the additional No Stopping restrictions these will be reported to the 25 August 2020 Hearings and Engagement Committee.

Cornice Place

- 21. A request for installation of No Stopping restrictions has been received from residents and Waste Management following an increase in vehicles parking in the cul-de-sac head of Cornice Place.
- 22. The additional parking has been associated with workers on the nearby development site parking in Cornice Place and using the walkway which connects through to River Road as shown in Figure 3 below:



Figure 3 – Walkway between Cornice Place and River Road providing access to development site for workers.

23. The layout of the cul-de-sac provides some parking in the central island for the residents in the immediate area and with sufficient lane width to get a truck around the cul-de-sac head as long as there is not vehicles parked in the area as shown in Figure 4 below:



Figure 4 – central area for parking in the Cornice Place cul-de-sac.

24. We have received a mixed reaction to the consultation on proposed installation of No Stopping restrictions in the cul-de-sac head of Cornice Place. While all residents support the need for

- No Stopping while the construction of the nearby development, some do not want this as a permanent situation.
- 25. Contact has been made with the development site to requesting them to encourage staff to park elsewhere but this has not improved the situation. Without No Stopping restrictions in place it is not possible to enforce.
- 26. Staff therefore propose to install the No Stopping restrictions using a special 'roadmarking tape'. Once the construction work has been completed at the nearby development, consultation will be undertaken with the residents to determine if they want to have the No Stopping markings made permanent or removed.

If there is a desire to have the No Stopping restrictions removed, we will report this through the Hearings and Engagement Committee and the tape will be uplifted. If there is a desire to retain the No Stopping restrictions, the tape will be replaced with roadmarking paint as needed.

Proposed safety improvements at Five Cross Roads

- 27. The 9 June 2020 Hearings and Engagement Committee considered a proposed for installation of safety improvement in Peachgrove Road just north of Five Cross Roads. This was proposed following the fatality of an elderly pedestrian at the intersection of Claude Street and Peachgrove Road when they were crossing Peachgrove Road.
- 28. Mr Deon Gregory, resident of #269 Peachgrove Road, spoke against proposed raised pedestrian platform. He noted the difficulty he had exiting his driveway, and his concerns regarding the proposed crossing location.
- 29. Staff undertook to report back to the next Hearings and Engagement Committee for options concerning moving the bus stop and/or the raised pedestrian crossing proposed near #276 Peachgrove Road.
- 30. An independent review of the proposed raised safety platform has been undertaken, along with an assessment of the two other locations that had been discussed at the 11 June 2020 Hearings and Engagement Committee meeting.




Figure 5 -Alternative Option 1 – Raised Safety Platform immediately north of Claude Street




Figure 6 – Alternative Option 2 – Raised Safety Platform immediately north of existing bus stops

- 31. Sketches of the two alternative locations were developed and are shown in Figures 5 and 6 below along with evaluation of these alternative solutions:

32. The review has indicated that the original proposal was in the preferred location but noted that there may be a little flexibility to move the raised platform slightly south (towards Five Cross Roads) to lessen the impact for any backing vehicle exiting from #269 Peachgrove Road

as shown in Figure 7 below. This could be worked through on site without requiring a full redesign of the proposed raised Safety Platform.



Figure 7 – Proposed raised safety platform with illustration of vehicle backing movement

- 33. A 'do nothing' approach is not considered appropriate at this location given the observed pedestrian demand in the vicinity in the proximity of the Medical Centre and the recent fatality.
- 34. Staff therefore recommend that approval be given for the installation of a raised safety platform across Peachgrove Road outside #267 Peachgrove Road to improve pedestrian safety and assist in reducing speeds in the Five Cross Roads shopping area.

Financial Considerations - Whaiwhakaaro Puutea

35. Funding for the implementation of the proposed changes is included in the 2020/21 City Transportation Operations and Parking Activity budgets.

Legal and Policy Considerations - Whaiwhakaaro-aa-ture

36. Staff confirm that the staff recommendation complies with the Council's legal and policy requirements.

Wellbeing Considerations - Whaiwhakaaro-aa-oranga tonutanga

- 37. The purpose of Local Government changed on the 14 May 2019 to include promotion of the social, economic, environmental and cultural wellbeing of communities in the present and for the future ('the 4 Wellbeings').
- 38. The subject matter of this report has been evaluated in terms of the 4 Wellbeings during the process of developing this report.
- 39. The recommendations set out in this report are consistent with that purpose.

Social

Item

40. The recommendations included in this report helps the community achieve their goals by ensuring their safety and ability to access key facilities such as education, health and employment.

Economic

41. The recommendations included in this report enable businesses to operate efficiently by ensuring safe access to their properties.

Environmental

42. There are no known environmental considerations associated with this matter.

43. There are no known cultural considerations associated with this matter.

Risks - Tuuraru

- 44. There are no known risks associated with the decisions required for this matter.
- 45. There are risks associated with not approving the recommendations in this report as set out as follows:
 - 2 b) parking restrictions to improve safety, and enable parking turnover
 - 2 c) parking restrictions provide for public transport operations
 - 2 d) safety and accessibility for pedestrians crossing Peachgrove Road in the vicinity of Claude Street.

Significance & Engagement Policy - *Kaupapa here whakahira/anganui* Significance

- 46. Staff considered the following factors under the Significance and Engagement Policy:
 - The form of engagement used in the past for similar proposals and decisions.
- 47. Based on these factors, staff have assessed that the recommendations have low significance.






