1.0 Overview Concept Plan

Background

BrodieHailwood and Acid Skate have been engaged to design the Fairfield Skate Park upgrade. The outcome of the project is for a renewed, improved skate park that provides increased capacity for users. The renewal also seeks to make the surrounding more attractive, family friendly and safe for users of the skate park and improve accessibility.

The original project scope included:

- Existing skate park renewal (refurbish existing and extend)
- Hard and soft landscaping surrounding skate space to integrate with Te Whare o te Ata and Fairfield Park.
- Integration of park lighting (a separate renewal project and budget)

During the pre-design phase HCC undertook extensive engagement with the local community to seek feedback on what they wanted the upgrade to include.

At a similar time, BarrierFree were also commissioned by HCC to complete an Accessibility Audit of Fairfield Skate Park (report dated 16 May 2023). The report makes recommendations to improvements accessible access to and use of the existing skate park.
