1(a). The Water treatment plant abstracted 21,260,860 m3 of water from the Waikato River between 1 July 2012 – 30 June 2013

2. What is the volume of water pumped back into the river in Pukete

2(a). The Wastewater Treatment plant discharged 16,970,323 m3 of treated effluent to the Waikato River between 1 July 2012 – 30 June 2013

3. What volume of water goes through metered properties/business, (water paid for by volume)

3(a). The total volume of water supplied to metered properties and businesses between 1 July 2012 – 30 June 2013 was 5,954,244 m3.

4. What volume of water goes to residential properties, (water paid for by rates)

4(a). The total volume of water supplied to unmetered properties between 1 July 2012 – 30 June 2013 was 14,514,803 m3"

Hamilton City Council's response is as follows:

1. What is the volume of water pumped out of Waikato river in Peacockes?

The Water Treatment Plant abstracted 23,118,029 m3 of water from the Waikato River between 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020.

2. What is the volume of water pumped back into the river in Pukete?

The Wastewater Treatment Plant discharged 16,894,195 m3 of treated water to the Waikato River between 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020.

3. What volume of water goes through metered properties/business, (water paid for by volume)?

The total volume of water supplied to metered properties and businesses between 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020 was 5,151,467 m3.

4. What volume of water goes to residential properties, (water paid for by rates)

The total volume of water supplied to unmetered properties between 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020 was 13,964,995 m3.

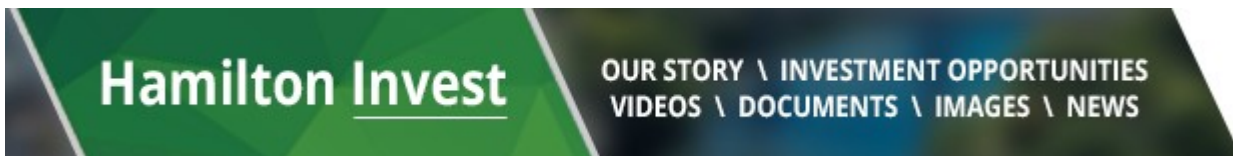
