Kia Ora,

I refer to your **information request below**, Hamilton City Council is able to provide the following response.

**You Requested:**

How many attended:

- a) Participants on bikes.
- b) Staff, and
- c) Support (Food Trucks, Entertainment, etc.?)
- d) What was the cost?

**Our Response:**

- a) Approximately 100 cyclists participated in the cycle portion of the event.
- b) One HCC Staff member assisted at Rostrevor St in a voluntary capacity.

The event was community-led and delivered. Two community members organised the event at Rostrevor St, and another organised the bike ride. There was also a community police patrol car at the front of the bike convoy.

- c) There were 2 Food Trucks at the event.

Entertainment was: DJ  
Escape Room and on-street games (ring toss and similar games)  
Stilt walkers and face painters.

- d) Total cost of the event was \$3,468.77, which was budgeted as part of the total cost of the Innovating Streets Project. Costs included:
  - o Entertainment - \$915.25
  - o Lights, staging, other event equipment - \$2083.52
  - o Toilets - \$180
  - o Promotion – posters, social media posts - \$290

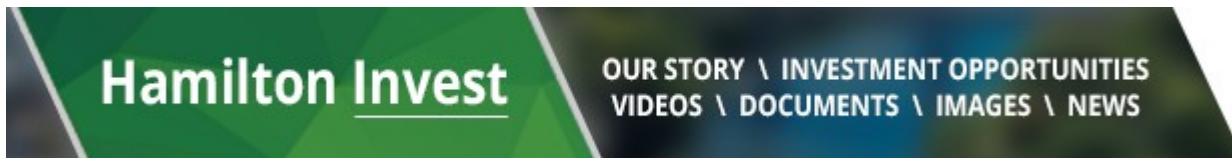
