Kia Ora,

I refer to your **information request below**, Hamilton City Council is able to provide the following response.

Your Request:

1. What weight and volume of Plastic building shrink wrap is used per annum in Hamilton?
2. How much of this is recycled and how much goes into landfill?
3. For public building work what agreements do the council have with the wrap providers to require them to recycle it? Or does the council take responsibility for this?
4. For the wrap that is recycled, where is the recycling done; for instance, is it processed and then shipped to China as pellets?
5. Is re-usable plastic building wrap used in some projects?

Our Response:

1. Hamilton City Council does not hold any information on this as plastic building shrink wrap is not a product that Hamilton City Council recycles.
As this information does not exist, we are refusing this part of your request in accordance with S 17(e) of LGOIMA.
2. See answer to question one.
3. Council does not have a large programme of public building work that requires building wrap. As such Council does not have any agreements in place with Wrap providers. Council values sustainability in its procurement processes and has some weighting on environmentally sustainable business practices and outputs, of which this subject matter would come under. Hamilton's Procurement Manual is under review at present and this type of matter will be considered.

5. Refer to answer to question 3. This matter will be addressed in a vertical build project in Rototuna that Council is about to procure. Our main facilities contractor has confirmed when there is a need for wrap, recyclable product is used.

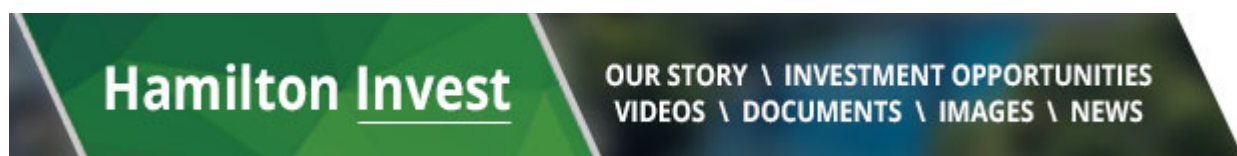
