Local Government Official Information Request

The following is in response to your official information request on Friday 22 October 2021 where you requested:

1. The number of properties within HCC's jurisdiction which are rated as producing trade waste; and
2. Confirmation of the assessment method HCC uses for rating of trade waste, i.e.
 - Quality/Quantity approach: sampling and analysis of trade waste;
 - Quantity approach: estimate of the volume of water usage.

HCC response is as follows:

1. The number of properties within HCC's jurisdiction which are rated as producing Trade Waste.

In total, there are 1125 properties within Hamilton City Council's jurisdiction which are rated as producing Trade Waste. Of the 1125 properties:

- 95 customers hold a conditional Trade Waste consent;
- 715 customers hold a permitted pre-treatment Trade Waste consent; and
- 315 customers hold a permitted Trade Waste consent.

2. Confirmation of the assessment method HCC uses for rating of trade waste, i.e.

- **Quality/Quantity approach: sampling and analysis of trade waste;**
- **Quantity approach: estimate of the volume of water usage.**

Through the Waikato Local Authority Shared Services Team, Hamilton City Council has adopted the Quality/Quantity approach for the assessment method used for rating Trade Waste.

For quality, the general characteristics of the waste are identified using wastewater sampling in order to inform the charging rate. Quality charge rates for 95 of our conditional consent trade waste customers include charges for:

- flow volume;
- suspended solids;
- cBOD (organic loading);
- Total Kjeldahl nitrogen;
- Total phosphorous;
- Arsenic; and
- COD (chemical loading).

For quantity, Hamilton City Council estimate the volume of water usage by the trade waste customer. If the customer does not have a dedicated trade waste meter to measure discharge, the volume of trade waste in the customers wastewater discharge is then estimated by Council via the customers water meter readings.

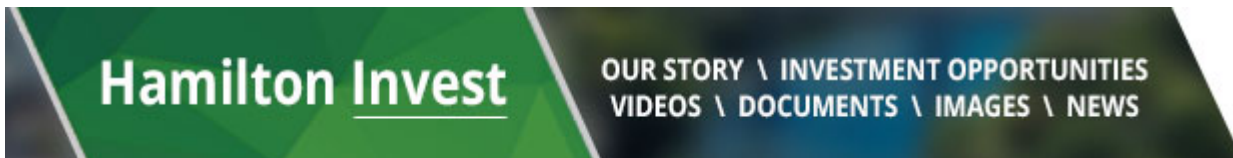
