I refer to your **information request below**, Hamilton City Council is able to provide the following response.

For the 2021-22 rating year there are 56,202 properties rated under the Council's residential rating category.

Note – this figure will include more than 'households'. For example – Vacant residential sections and residential multi-unit properties are included in this total.

This figure will increase each year due to development around the city. Rates are set each year based on the number of properties as at 30 June.
