Infrastructure Alliance (IA) complete maintenance and renewal activities on the HCC transport assets.

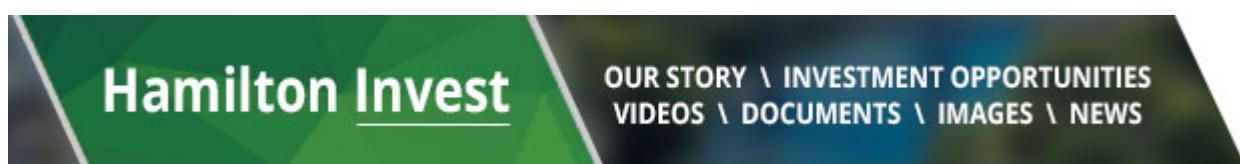
Infrastructure Alliance use the in-house Downer Traffic team to complete the physical work aspects of Temporary Traffic Management (TTM). As an internal supplier, it would be very time consuming to separate staff/plant costs between our normal activities and that of TTM. As such we have calculated an average across all our works which we believe is a reasonable estimation of TTM cost across all work types. Based on this estimate, please see the values below for the last 5 years.
