### Our Response

The revenue from parking and traffic infringements is distributed to support the following areas:

- management fees for the on-street parking sensors and payment systems
- costs relating to running of the parking unit
- debt collection fees
- 50% of all traffic infringements collected, excluding parking infringements, is paid to Ministry of Transport as per the agreement between Ministry of Transport and Hamilton City Council to ensure legal and safe vehicles are operating on our roads.


