Kia Ora,

I refer to your **information request below**, Hamilton City Council is able to provide the following response. We understand that Waikato Regional Council are providing response to parts a, b and c of your request as the relevant regulatory authority. So our response provided below is solely in response to part d and e of your request.

Your request- part D and E:

- d. A copy of the design plans (in their current state) for the extension of Whatukooruru Drive to the east of its current formation, including earthworks cut/fill plans, sediment control plans and any technical reports relating to Wetlands, SNA's and Bat Habitat protection.
- e. A copy of the Outline Plan for the extension of the East-West Road (Whatukooruru Drive) to the east of its current formation, including associated plans, management plans and technical reports

Our Response- part D and E:

To provide further context to this request, Council notes: Any aspect of the PC5 proceedings seeking to determine access arrangements to the designation is beyond the scope of PC5 and beyond the delegation of the hearing panel. This matter sits solely with that part of HCC performing the role and function as requiring authority responsible for delivering the designated works. HCC as requiring authority has, over several years, sought to engage with the landowner of 143 & 148 Hall Road on design details. The landowner has chosen not to engage and the design has not been completed as a consequence. Concept designs have been supplied to the landowner through the Environment Court assisted mediation process.

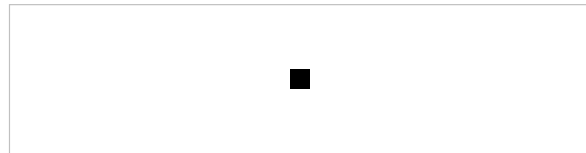

Thank you for your efforts (to date) to source information relating to my request for information relating to resource consents relating to roading in the Peacocks (Southern) Links area. This information is required for the purpose of preparing evidence for the forthcoming PC5 – Peacocke Structure Plan hearings. On the current timetable that evidence is required to be filed by Friday 16 Sept.

For the avoidance of doubt the following information is sought as an Urgent Official Information request under s.10 of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (as it should already have been treated) to ensure this information is available for the preparation of evidence in accordance with the set evidence exchange timetable.

The information requested is as follows:

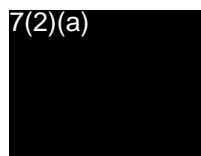
- a. A copy of all resource consents granted by Waikato Regional Council for works associated with the Peacocks/ Southern Links roading Network (including the associated “stamped” approved plans), including any consents granted under the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020.
- b. A copy of any current resource consent applications, including any applications lodged under the Resource Management (National Environmental Standards for Freshwater) Regulations 2020 to Waikato Regional Council for works associated with the Peacocks/ Southern Links roading Network (including the associated application plans, the AEE and the technical reports relating to Wetlands, SNA’s and Bat Habitat protection).
- c. A copy of any S.92 requests and any s.92 responses made in respect of any current resource consent applications to Waikato Regional Council for works associated with the Peacocks/ Southern Links roading Network including the associated application plans and technical reports relating to Wetlands, SNA’s and Bat Habitat protection.
- d. A copy of the design plans (in their current state) for the extension of Whatukooruru Drive to the east of its current formation, including earthworks cut/fill plans, sediment control plans and any technical reports relating to Wetlands, SNA’s and Bat Habitat protection.

The information I have received to date comprises:

1. Consent Evaluation Report APP141620 dated 19 Aug 2020 (N.B. that document is incomplete as the “stamped approved plans” are not included).

For the avoidance of doubt - I am not requesting copies of consents relating to the new Waikato River Bridge (currently under construction).
I am willing to received all documents in electronic format.
