I refer to your **information request below**, Hamilton City Council is able to provide the following response.

**Your Request 1:**

As requested could you please inform me as to how many pedestrians have been in accidents in any area in Hamilton that has these "" traffic calming "" judder bars or speed restrictions

**Our Response 1:**

We do not hold the information you have requested so per section [12 of LGOIMA](#), we will be transferring your request:

*Section 12 –*

*Where a request is made to any local authority, and the information held (or some of the information) is not held/or believed to be held or related more closely to another local or authority – the request can be transferred to the relevant local authority. Transfers shall be done promptly and in no later than 10 working days after the day of receiving the request.*

We have transferred this part of your request to NZTA/Waka Kotahi for a response – who we have CC'd in this email. They will contact you directly with regards to this request.

**Your Request 2:**

I am aware that the road beside Founders theatre was reinstated as a thru road because the Ambulance service use it so often and your traffic people did not consult with them, was that a gigantic waste of money, I would suggest that many of these speed bumps are the same, like the chicane on Howell Ave that was taken out because it wasn't doing as expected.
