Kia ora,

We refer to your information request below. Hamilton City Council provides the following response.

Your request:

- 1. I ask that you provide a total of any raised object in the carriageway - be it zebra, a raised safety platform complete with a courtesy crossing, or a raised roundabout entrance.*
- 2. Then, following that, please indicate where funding has come from for each example.*

Our response:

1. Based on our current records, there are more than 850 of these devices in the city.
2. Our current records do not include information on how these were funded. Therefore, as per S17(e) of LGOIMA this information doesn't exist. However, funding sources are likely to be:
 - By developers who have included these devices in new roads vested to the city
 - Rates/loan funding and Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency co-investment for those installed by Hamilton City Council.
