Other than the attached we don't have any specific information for the following reasons:

- We do not have a parks signage policy.
- We do not have asset records that show the existing signage in our parks and green spaces.

- When signs are replaced, they are usually done as part of a wider park's renewal project and the need for replacement signage is identified during project scoping.
