Our response:

There is no feasibility study for raised safety platforms for Rototuna. Please see this report attached via WSP.

The attached public document 'Rototuna Rocket Public Transport Route Assessment' is the document that was used to inform the use of in-lane bus stops in the Rototuna area. The use of raised safety platforms is determined on a project-by-project basis. Raised safety platforms are part of the safe systems approach to road safety which underpins New Zealand's national road safety strategy.
