We have been made aware that your other questions have been answered by our LTP team, the only one we are answering is the one above.

We receive funding from the following Waikato Regional Council in 22/23 towards specific operational costs:

- Waikato Regional Council Civil Defence & Emergency \$550k
- Waikato Regional Council Future Proof \$295k
- Waikato Regional Council Parks - Nature in the City \$10,000
- Waikato Regional Council Enviro school funding \$35,250
- Waikato Regional Council Emissions Funding Support \$15,527
