Our response:

1. **The total cost of installing the 10 pedestrian crossings on North City Road**

The five pedestrian crossings next to Te Kete Aronui Rototuna Library were delivered by Council as part of the Rototuna Village programme of work. The cost for these five crossings was \$293,597.

The remaining five crossings near the commercial development were delivered by private developers. Council is unable to provide the costs of the crossings delivered by developers.

2. **A breakdown of costs including but not limited to planning, construction, traffic management, and any additional infrastructure.**

The construction of the five pedestrian crossings delivered by Council were part of the as part of the Rototuna Village programme of work. We have not assigned an individual

breakdown of these costs to the pedestrian crossings.
You have the right to seek an investigation and review by the Ombudsman of this decision.
