*Would you be able to supply the number of road calming speed humps that have been built on roads within Hamilton City since January 2020 please?*

**Our response:**

Speed humps are not something that Council singles out in our data for all projects or asset management purposes, when a raised safety platform is implemented, it is part of a larger project. We do not hold data of only speed bumps.

If there is a specific project that you are wanting further details about, we can provide this, but we do not hold data on speed bumps only.
