We refer to your information request below. Hamilton City Council provides the following response.

Your request:

My queries are as follows:

1. *Does HCC carry out any emissions testing? If so, what were the findings of the data?*
2. *What are the emissions ranges that are standard?*
3. *What are the emissions level that are regarded as acceptable?*
4. *Who collects this data?*

Our response:

Our greenhouse gas emissions data for the city is a collection of National and Regional data. That is then scaled down to the Hamilton population. Waikato Regional Council have coordinated this process for the region for the last two emissions profiles (2018/19 and 2021/22).

The data is available here on our website page - [Emissions Profile](#). There are two graphs that show the emissions city wide and also emissions from Council ie: the running of our Hamilton Zoo and Waterworld. The Council greenhouse gas emissions profile is calculated from our own data.

Also linked in the above is [Our Climate Future](#) – this is the strategy that we have to reduce our emissions and includes targets for emissions reduction for 2030 and for 2050 for both citywide and council emissions.
