**Our response:**

Thank for your query on the construction of a new playground in the Grandview Heights

neighbourhood.

As discussed, in our phone call unfortunately there is no funding allocated to the development of a new playground in the Grandview Heights area in the current Long-Term Plan (2021-2031).

We agree that it is important to get outside and play, and we are continuously striving to deliver a playground network which provides fair opportunities to play for all our communities. We recognise there may be some challenges for your family and community with accessing a playground nearby. However, building a new playground is a big investment so we cannot consider the development of a new playground unless there is a clearly identified need for that community.

The Long-Term Plan sets out Council's priorities. It includes detailed information on the activities, services, and projects we intend to deliver, which dictates what the proposed rates and debt will be for the next 10 years. Council is in the process of shaping the next Long-Term Plan (2024-2034) which will set out the priorities for the next 10 years.

If you feel strongly that we should develop a playground at 53-61 Farnborough Drive, your best avenue is to make a submission through the Long-Term Plan process. As discussed, I would suggest that you take some time to gather more voices from your local community to include in your submission as that will provide greater evidence of the need for a playground in the Grandview Heights area.

You will have a chance to have your say about our plans for the next 10 years, during the consultation process of the Long-Term Plan which is happening next year. You will hear more from us about the Long-Term Plan in due course – we encourage you to share your voice then.
