We refer to your information request below. Hamilton City Council provides the following response.

The number of raised pedestrian crossings planned to be started by the end of the 2023-2024 financial year (but not necessarily completed in this financial year) which are expected to cost \$100,000 or more upon completion. Our response:

We have constructed 18 raised pedestrian crossings so far in 2023-24. The number of raised pedestrian crossings currently under construction are eight, and there are four proposed raised pedestrian crossings to be constructed within the remainder of the financial year 23/24 (this is subject to change via Council Decision). Please see locations and number of crossings reflected below:
